The Role

As a Junior Chaplain, you will work closely with the Person in Charge of Catholic Life (PICCL) and the Lay Chaplain to strategically promote and develop the Chaplaincy offer for pupils in school. You will be a member of a highly professional team, and will work with them to care for and nurture our pupils.

Responsibilities

You will be tasked with producing Daily Reflections for use in Form Time and helping the PICCL with monitoring Form Time activities. You will also help the PICCL and Lay Chaplain prepare and deliver Collective Worship and Liturgy, including Masses and services. You will take ownership of the Chapel, monitoring the attendance and inclusivity of chaplaincy activities at break and lunchtime to support pupils.
