

During school closures you may still receive applications for admission to the school although I hope that these will be minimal given the unprecedented circumstances. Schools will still need to consider and offer or refuse places as normal however, it may be that due to difficulties around arranging meetings there may be a delay in parents being able to receive a decision. Where that is the case, I would suggest that applications are acknowledged, and parents advised that they will be notified of the outcome of their application as soon as governors can meet to consider it. The DfE are understanding that these are not normal times for schools. When further guidance is received from the DfE with regards to admissions and appeals then this will be shared with all schools.
