



DFE GUIDANCE (UPDATED 10.10.22)

Primary schools should have a minimum 100/30Mbps

Secondary schools, all-through schools and FE colleges should have a connection with the capacity to deliver 1Gbps


Broadband should be provided using a full fibre connection. (LL or FTTP)

Ensure resilience and maintain continuity of service



The DfE focus is on higher bandwidth, service agreements and resilience due to the ever increasing reliance on network connectivity

As more cloud services are used for running the school's finance, MIS, HR, payroll and telephone systems, the impact of a failure is greater.

Leased lines are symmetrical e.g 100 upload and 100 download.

Others are asymmetrical e.g. FTTP – 330 download and 50 upload; FTTC 80 download 20 upload.

Schools must ensure the children’s safety by use of filtering - KCSiE

Exa have a resilient network – complete transparency of every route and have shadow VLANs in place to provide backup routing.

Network team monitors usage and has found cyber security issues proactively which the school are informed about to take action.

Exa won the Cyber Security service award at the ISPA awards this month.

Core Network uptime is excellent.

The learning program is led by Alan O’Donohoe CAS master teacher and ensure children and teacher are taught computing and safety lessons in an engaging imaginative method.

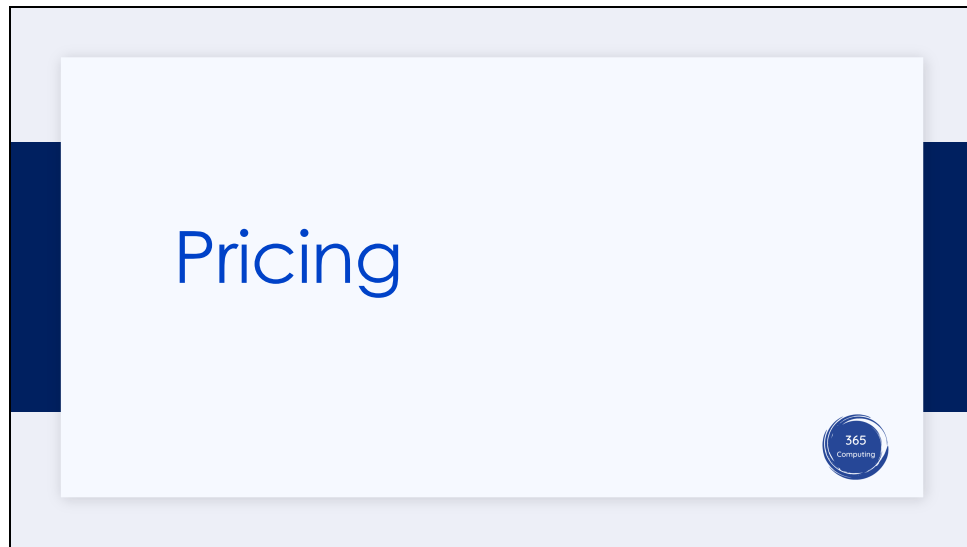
Transparency and honesty from provider. See your usage reports at any time to ensure you're on the right package.

What does your DSL want?

Safety for Children – filtering and monitoring. Ensuring even BYOD are filtered. That devices sent home can still provide filtered connections.

What does your Network Manager / Tech want?

Quick responses to change requests on (a) firewall (b) filtering (c) configs (d) faults
Network Resilience - backup policies at supply end and local backup lines.
Advice alongside support



Leased lines are site specific – depends on your telecom zone.

Where Excess Construction Charges might arise (eg no fibre going to your schools) the telecoms company will pay the first £2500 of these. Only once have I had a school required to pay ECCs and it was under 800 for about 7 days work.

They are rare in most schools.

Contact for a price.

This can usually be provided with the hour.

FTTP is nearly always under 3400 for 330/50 incl full management and filtering.

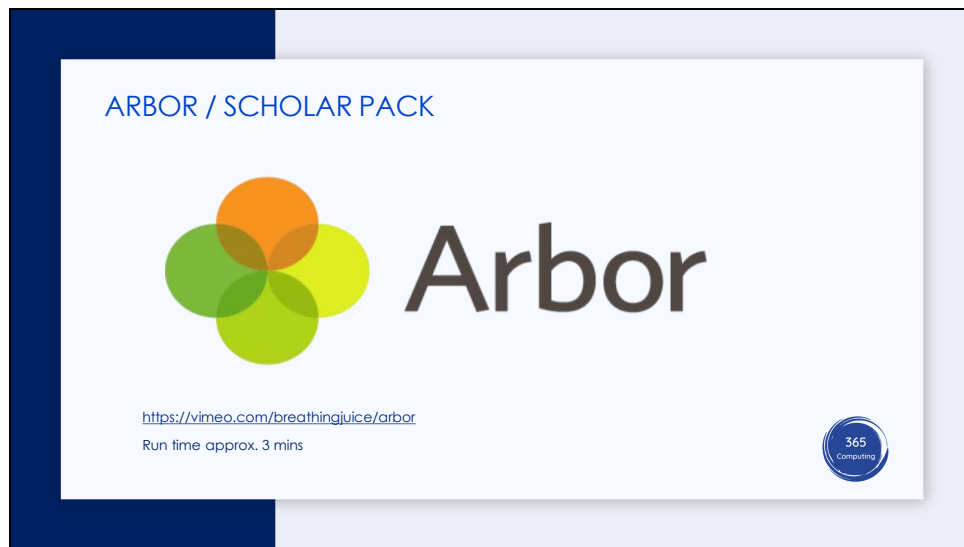
