Aim of the European General Data Protection Regulation is to create a 'one stop shop' for data protection with a common set of rules across the EU



It will have a major impact on the way schools manage personal data including:



Web privacy policies



Employee records



Pupils' details

When the new regulations come into effect: relevant after Brexit

Your school will need to consider the following:



Consent



Governance



Privacy by Design



Right to be forgotten



Subject Access Requests



Data Processors' Liability



Mandatory breach notification

Maximum penalty for businesses who do not comply:

€20<sup>M</sup>

or 4% worldwide turnover (whichever is greater)
